CA CARPET STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM - NOTICE TO COLLECTOR/SORTERS
December 2015

On behalf of CARE, this document serves as notice to program participating collector/sorters of CA post-consumer carpet regarding recent updates affecting the California Carpet Stewardship Program incentives and reporting.

1. New Program Participant Agreements—Effective January 2016

New agreements were adopted by CARE as a requirement for all participating processors and manufacturers in the California Carpet Stewardship Program, effective January 2015. In July 2015, this requirement was extended to Collector/Sorters. New 2016 Agreements incorporate several adjustments to the previous 2015 contract. These changes include:

- Monthly reporting and monthly payouts of reporting incentives
- New Collector/Sorter Entrepreneur incentive
- The term of the agreement is now two years, effective January 1, 2016.
- The damages provisions were revised to convey that only direct damages are recoverable, including any overpayments of AB 2398 incentives.

Agreements incorporate various program policies into a single document and are required to be executed by all collector/sorters participating in the incentive program, effective for December 2015 reporting period.

Agreements are attached to this notice.

Failure to submit signed agreements by the stated deadline will forfeit eligibility for incentive payment.
