



Starting April 1, 2022, the assessment charged on all carpet in California will be based on carpet type (broadloom vs. carpet tile) and presence of 10% or more post-consumer material.

The new assessment rates are:

Differential Assessment Levels as of April 1, 2022		
PRODUCT	> or = 10% Post-Consumer Content	<10% Post-Consumer Content
BROADLOOM	\$0.33/square yard	\$0.35/square yard
CARPET TILE	\$0.48/square yard	\$0.50/square yard

The carpet assessment is mandated by California law. Funds support carpet recycling in the state.
